

Declaration of Covenants and Deed Restrictions

- conditions we all must adhere to
- tell us what we can/cannot do on our property.
- Everyone accepted them at closing.
- written to protect both Oak Run Associates Ltd. and the residents.

Available to view:

- Phone book (abbreviated version)
- Marion County Clerk of Court – Official Records



Examples of Covenants

- **One household resident must be 55 or older**
- All **residents** must be 18+
- Younger guests can visit up to 30 days/year
- Guests are defined as overnight and live at least 1 hour away.
- No more than 4 residents per household
- Exterior decorations are limited. (Refer to Deed Restriction or email Corporate Office for details)
- All exterior changes must be approved by Architectural Review Board (ARB). (ORAL)
- **NO** parking on grass
- Maintain your lamp post & mailbox

Who enforces the Covenants?

- The Developer (Oak Run Associates Ltd.) created and enforces the Covenants.** Not all Neighborhoods have the exact same rules, but they are all similar.





The ARB Process

- Any changes to the outside of your home requires an ARB...(ex. Painting, new windows, landscaping, cutting trees, convert a Lanai into permanent room of your home, new roof, siding replacement, etc.)
- Review the online form www.oakrunflorida.com, (print out) *Community Service Request* (on Orhaocalafl.com or Page 14 of directory).
- Complete & Submit form to the black box at Orchid Club. (*Include drawings, pictures, details, etc.*) best method is send info via Email to arbrequests@deccahomes.com
- You should receive a reply in 30 days

SECURITY

Our Entrances

- 3 gates.
- open 24 hours.
- Residents enter by recognition of a “RFID” Tag on windshield
- Guests enter their Drivers License into a Kiosk.
- Residents are asked to register their visitors and service companies with Envera via phone app, email, or by phone.

- ENVERA Customer Service # (877-936-8372)



- The 484 gate is residents only. No visitors or service vehicles.
- Tell vendors, service contractors, family, and friends which gate to use.



AT THE GATES:

- Please come to a complete stop!
 - The exit gates are magnetic, approach slowly as you need to be close to trigger it to open.
 - **DO NOT TAILGATE THROUGH!**
 - When the gate goes up, don't dawdle, drive through.
 - Damage to gates are the responsibility of the person who did the damage. Fines can go up to \$5000.

OUR COMMUNITY

A 55+ Community



- Federal Regulations require us to verify that there is at least one occupant 55 or older in the home.
- Whether you are a renter or an owner you should have filled out an Affidavit of Compliance. If you did not you will be asked to do so and show proof of age.
- Surveys are also done every few years to verify we are compliant.

POOLS & HOT TUBS

All Pools & Hot Tubs

- All guests must be accompanied by a resident
- Children's hours vary and are posted at each pool – you may also find children's hours in the Newsletter, online at orhaocalafl.com>2024 Events Calendar>pool schedule.
- **No one** under the age of 18 in hot tubs. (This is a Florida Health Department rule.)
- **Rules are posted at each pool.** Please take note and follow them
- **NO SMOKING**

- **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT POOLS**



Pool Tags/Bracelets

WHO IS ORHA?

Oak Run Homeowners Association or ORHA

Is not a real HOA .

According to Oak Run Declarations of Covenants and Restrictions Article IV and the Articles of Incorporation of Oak Run Homeowners Association, Inc. Article IV Section 1 and summarized here as: *The Primary purpose of Oak Run Homeowners Association Inc., a Florida corporation not-for-profit, has been created to provide for organizing the recreational, social, and cultural activities desired by the Owners of Homesites within the Oak Run development, more particularly described as and recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida and to provide a forum for discussion and communication among the Members and management of matters, pertinent to the Owners.*

ORHA

- **Not** part of Oak Run Associates Ltd.
- Does **not** pay Oak Run Associates Ltd. fees
- Does **not** collect monthly dues or service maintenance fees
- Does **not** impose fines
- Does **not** handle ARBs, security, maintenance, or lawn services.



ORHA is:

- ORHA is Completely a Volunteer not for profit Organization made up of Residents
- An **activities**-oriented organization that raises its money from ticketed events and donations.
- **Liaison** between the residents and management of Oak Run Associates Ltd.
- **Approves** new clubs & **Schedules** the use of the facilities that are provided by Oak Run Associates Ltd.
- Sets (with Oak Run Associates Ltd.) rules for use of those facilities.
- Enhances some facilities to increase functionality for our residents. (e.g., Microphones, ice machine at Orchid Club, etc.)






